Amendment

**To The Mountain High Homeowners Association
Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions
As Recorded Vol. 1999, Page 2591**

The Mountain High Homeowners Association Board of Directors, at it's February 19, 1999 meeting, proposed the following amendment to the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions. In excess of 75% of the membership voted, by special mail-in ballot, to adopt the amendment.

ARTICLE 7, SECT. 7.5 OF THE MOUNTAIN HIGH DECLARATIONS OF COVENANTS, CONDITIONS, AND RESTRICTIONS EXECUTED JAN. 19, 1999 IS DELETED IN IT'S ENTIRETY AND REPLACED BY THE FOLLOWING.

7.5 : SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS: SHOULD THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS DEEM IT TO BE OF ADVANTAGE TO THE OWNERS WITHIN THE MOUNTAIN HIGH ASSOCIATION TO IMPOSE A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR DEVELOPMENT OF A PARTICULAR FACILITY OR TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE COVERAGE OF MAINTENANCE COSTS CAUSED BY CONDITIONS OR OCCURRENCES NOT CONTEMPLATED AT THE TIME OF APPROVAL OF THE ANNUAL BUDGET, THE IMPOSITION OF SUCH SPECIAL ASSESSMENT SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF 7.5.2 SET FORTH BELOW.

7.5.2: IN THE CASE OF A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200) PER LOT DURING ONE CALENDAR YEAR, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS, BY MAJORITY VOTE AND SUBJECT TO PRESENCE OF A QUORUM, IS EMPOWERED TO IMPOSE SUCH AN ASSESSMENT.

IN THE CASE OF A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT IN
EXCESS OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200) PER
LOT DURING ONE CALENDAR YEAR, SUCH
ASSESSMENT MUST BE APPROVED BY NOT LESS
THAT SIXTY PER CENT (60%) OF THE VOTES CAST
BY WRITTEN BALLOT DIRECTED TO ALL OWNERS.

IN THE EVENT THAT SUCH ASSESSMENT IS
IMPOSED, THE MONIES DERIVED THEREFROM
SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN A SEPARATE ACCOUNT
AND SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE
APPROVED BY THE OWNERS.
